The Roanoke County C.O.P.S. Camp is a collaborative effort between the Roanoke County Police Department, Roanoke County Police Foundation, Roanoke County Parks and Recreation, and Roanoke County Schools. Our main focus is having FUN!!! We emphasize teamwork and safety to give each young participant an experience they will not soon forget. Any rising sixth, seventh, or eighth grader in a Roanoke County School is welcome to apply for a camper's spot.

A total of 60 camper slots are available. The school resource officer for your child's school will review the application to endorse the application. Selection will be based on citizenship, character, trustworthiness, and being in good standing within the school.

Currently registration is open to all Roanoke Valley students that are rising sixth, seventh, or eighth graders. Registration will end on May 10th, 2013.

Proper camp attire is all you are required to bring. We provide the food, excitement, fun, and new friends. Each camper will be mentored by a Roanoke County Police Officer through the many activities at Camp Roanoke. During the evening and night hours, the Camp Roanoke staff will lead all activities. Contact your school resource officer for further information.

Please complete the registration application to the right. Additional information and complete enrollment forms will be mailed by Camp Roanoke to the home address and email listed on the registration form in May.

This is a residential overnight camp for the entire week. Campers will arrive on Sunday afternoon and depart on Friday afternoon.

The camp costs approximately \$245 for each camper. This year's camp will be partially funded by donations, so there is a one time registration fee of \$185 to attend.
