

Reimagine Hollins




Thanks for sharing your ideas!

Over 100 people joined us for two community meetings earlier this month. We learned more about the opportunities and challenges that residents, business owners and employees see for transportation, development and economic growth in Hollins.



Here are a few suggestions we heard:

- Add sidewalks, crosswalks, bike lanes and/or shared-use paths to increase safety for all users in the study area
- Redevelop commercial areas into a mix of housing, locally-owned businesses and places to hang out
- Rebuild the library at a more central, connected location
- Protect, preserve and enhance natural resources and parks


Next Steps:
