

AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ROANOKE COUNTY, VIRGINIA, HELD AT THE ROANOKE COUNTY ADMINISTRATION CENTER, TUESDAY, MARCH 23, 2021

RESOLUTION 032321-6 ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR ROANOKE COUNTY, VIRGINIA: INCORPORATING THE DRAFT (DATED JANUARY 8, 2021) OAK GROVE CENTER PLAN

WHEREAS, § 15.2-2223 of the Code of Virginia requires that every jurisdiction shall adopt a comprehensive plan for the physical development of their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, § 15.2-2230 of the Code of Virginia requires that the Planning Commission review the comprehensive plan at least once every five years to determine whether it is advisable to amend the plan; and

WHEREAS, it is proposed that the Comprehensive Plan be amended to incorporate the Draft Oak Grove Center Plan, dated January 8, 2021, into the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed amendment to the Comprehensive Plan on February 2, 2021, after posting, advertisement and notices as required by § 15.2-2225 and § 15.2-2204 of the Code of Virginia.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Roanoke County, Virginia, as follows:

- 1) The Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended by incorporating the Draft Oak Grove Center Plan, dated January 8, 2021, into the Comprehensive Plan with the following additional amendment:
 - a. The Plan's Community Engagement section shall be updated to incorporate information regarding public hearings held by the City of

Roanoke (held before the City's Planning Commission on March 8, 2021, and before City Council on March 15, 2021), and the public hearing held on this date (March 23, 2021) before the Board.


2) This resolution is effective upon its adoption.
