



# Fall 2023 Community Survey Summary

84 Responses



- Half of respondents said that **vehicular access and safety** was the most important issue in the study area, with 25% listing it as the second most important issue.
  - **Speeding** ranked a close second, with 37% listing it as the most important issue and 32% as the second most important.
- Top four safety issues:
  1. 84% **navigating narrow road**
  2. 78% **speeding**
  3. 74% **one lane bridge**
  4. 60% **sight distance challenges**
- 23% of respondents currently **walk** in the study area and 6% **cycle**.
- 35% would like to **walk** and 17% would like to **cycle**.
- 55% do not desire to use a mode of travel other than a **personal vehicle**.
- In the open-ended survey responses (see presentation in binder), many respondents expressed the desire for Carson Road (especially the bridge) to be **widened** and for **shoulder improvements** to be constructed.
- Many also stated that they do not want **cut-through traffic** to be encouraged and that **speeding** is a concern that they do not want to worsen because of roadway changes.
