Residential Generator Guide

Part 1 - Application, Site Plan and Related Documents

Completed Permit Application
Plot/site plan
Proof of Ownership (if not current in property records)
Owner's Affidavit completed on permit application if Owner Permit
Contractor's License, when required
County Business License, when required
List of sub-contractors if any to be used on project

Part 2 – Construction Documents to be onsite during inspections

Generator installation instructions from the manufacturer.

Manufacturer specification documents on all equipment to be installed.

System Description (702.5.2.A NEC 2008) – Identify if the generator will be providing Full Load or Load management power.

Method for Preventing "Back Feeding" – Identify if the generator will have an automatic or manual transfer switch.

Gas line installed per code, natural gas or propane

Signage installation (702.8 NEC 2008)

Inspections Required during generator Installation

- 1. Final Mechanical
- 2. Final Electrical (generator must be operational during the final inspection to ensure all equipment functions)

The two inspections required can be completed at same time.
