### Topic 1: Infrastructure Improvements

1. Identify and prioritize bridge/roads, tunnels needing improvement
2. Sustainability of repairs
3. Environmental (consciousness)
4. Develop Strategy process to prioritize (HB2)
5. Secure funding for repairs
6. Identify areas needing higher capacity
7. Planning Commission review traffic impacts on development
8. New development = Smart Development
9. Greenway complete – as transportation network
